Geoff trains emerging national missionaries for leadership positions in cross-cultural church planting

We have been in South Africa for two amazing weeks with our Indian friends in Johannesburg. They surprised us with a gathering of people who had been part of our church plant in the late 70s when we were missionaries here. To our delight, they had planned for Geoff to lead a baby dedication for 14-week-old twin girls, the great-granddaughters of one of the first converts from Hinduism. This woman was nearly killed by her irate husband when she refused to bow down and pray to the Hindu gods. Eventually, her whole family turned to Christ. For the next month we are teaching Comparative Religions to a class of 20 students (mostly Africans from the Zulu tribe) at Union Bible Institute in Hilton, South Africa. Several of the students did a great job in presenting the beliefs and practices of Shembeism, a cult that has attracted nearly 4 million Zulus. (Shembe is the black messiah to his followers.) They even dressed up and decorated the classroom to resemble their worship site, then ended by demonstrating to the class how this cult has deviated from the Bible and how to reach them with God's truth. We are full of joy as we ministry here in South Africa to both the African and Indian communities.
